

# **Local Government Pay – The National Joint Council (NJC)**

The below provides an update regarding the 2024 Local Government Pay Award.

### **Trade Union Pay Claim**

On 29 February 2024, Unison, Unite and GMB lodged their pay claim as follows:

- An increase of at least £3,000 or 10 per cent (whichever is greater) on all spinal column points.
- Reviews of the gender, ethnicity and disability pay gaps in local government.
- A two-hour reduction in the working week, with no detriment.
- An additional day of annual leave for personal or well-being purposes (with term-time only staff also receiving a full day rather than a pro rata amount, that they can use at any time. including term time).
- A phased approach to reaching a minimum pay rate of £15 an hour in a maximum of two years, sooner if possible.

### **National Employers Full and Final Pay Offer**

On 16 May 2024, the National Employers met and agreed to make the following one-year (1 April 2024 to 31 March 2025), the following full and final pay offer, with effect from 1 April 2024:

- £1,290 (pro rata for part-time employees) to be paid as a consolidated, permanent addition on all NJC pay points 2 to 43 inclusive.
- 2.50 per cent on all pay points 43 and above (but graded below deputy chief officer, in accordance with Green Book Part 2 Para 5.4).
- An increase of 2.50 per cent on all allowances.

This would achieve a bottom rate of pay of £12.26 (which equates to a pay increase of 5.77 per cent for employees on pay point 2) and everyone on the NJC pay spine would receive a minimum of 2.50 per cent pay increase.

The offer, if accepted would increase the national pay bill by 4.03 per cent. Local pay bills will vary.











## **Trade Union Responses**

The Trade Union Responses to the full and final pay offer made by the National Employers:

- Unison will consult with its members, with a recommendation to reject the offer. Consultation will run from Wednesday 5 June 2024 to Monday 28 June 2024 at midday.
- GMB will not be making a recommendation but will be balloting their members from Monday 3 June 2024 to Friday 5 July 2024 at midday.
- Unite is now undertaking consultative ballots with a recommendation to reject the offer.
